Coach Display Information

COACH MOVE-IN

- Coaches should be by the loading docks at 8 AM on Wednesday, February 3.
- Loading Docks Location | To access the loading facilities at BMO Centre, enter Stampede Park from the north at the corner of 12 Ave. and Stampede Trail S.E., and then turn west (right) onto 13 Ave. and into the loading area.

COACH MOVE-OUT

- Tuesday, February 9 at 4:45 PM
- Coaches will be able to move out as soon as the Networking Floor is cleared for a path to the loading docks.

COACH AREA

- ABA is providing the carpet in the coach area.
- Any additional services/décor required (i.e. electric, furniture) is your responsibility to order and pay.
- Exhibitor kits will be available October 28, 2026.

STAFFED BOOTH HOURS

Displays to be set by 1:00 PM on Saturday, Feb 6. Displays do not need to be staffed during the meal functions except for Tuesday's All-Delegate Breakfast on the Networking Floor.

- Sunday, Feb 7 | 9 AM - 5:30 PM
- Monday, Feb 8 | 9 AM - 5:30 PM
- Tuesday, Feb 9 | 7:30 AM - 4:30 PM

REGULATIONS

All vehicles must be secured as follows and **will be inspected** prior to entry into BMO Centre:

- Complete and submit the Vehicle Display Permit Form.
- Battery does **NOT** need to be disconnected. Ignition fuse **DOES** need to be disabled/removed.
- Fuel tanks and fill openings shall be closed and sealed to prevent tampering
- ¼ tank is **approved** fuel level
- Driver window **must** be open at all time to hear smoke detector
- Fire extinguisher **must** be visible at all times during display.
- Vehicles should be monitored for any kind of fuel leak (liquid or vapor) and if any present the vehicle must be re-located outside immediately
- No electric buses permitted.
- No studded tires.
- Ethanol, methanol, or nitromethane fuel tanks must be completely empty.
- An approved drip tray must be placed underneath the vehicle(s) for floor protection.
- Liquid Propane and Compressed Natural Gas tanks must be empty and purged. Certificate required from company conducting the purge.
- Comply with restrictions on spray bottles for cleaning. WHMIS labeling required for all spray bottle.
- Must bring additional set of keys. Ignition keys for vehicles on display shall be kept at a designated location determined by ABA in the event of an emergency.
- Coach emergency form will be sent closer to the event and will be collected with the extra set of keys.
- Vehicles crossing the border | vehicles on carriers vs driven
 - Vehicles on carriers:
 - Best and simplest way to go, easy. Enters on a temporary basis(basic paperwork)
 - If you are driving the vehicle across the border:
 - In addition to clearances, you will need:
 - The moment you drive a vehicle is on Canadian public roads, it is regulated as a commercial move —even if it's "just for display"
 - Proper Alberta permits or IRP
 - Fuel tax compliance
 - Valid Canadian insurance
 - Correct driver credentials
 - No passenger use
